On Monday, April 22, 2019, the Lakes Region Planning Commission will hold a regular meeting at the Gilford Public Library in Gilford. The topic for the evening is **Lakes Region Solid Waste Management** with a presentation from LRPC staff members David Jeffers, Regional Planner, and Paige Wilson, Intern and Master's candidate, Plymouth State University.

Solid waste challenges have never loomed larger and the costs are edging up. Many communities are finding that it is cost-prohibitive to recycle. Hauling and tipping fees charged to communities vary widely and fees charged to residents for C&D, electronics, and bulky items are also very different from community to community. Budget cuts at the state level have greatly reduced assistance and training opportunities for local solid waste operators. In response to these challenges, LRPC is in the third year of its regional solid waste management initiative. Come learn about the assistance that we are providing to communities and the regional joint purchasing we are introducing to help our member communities save money.

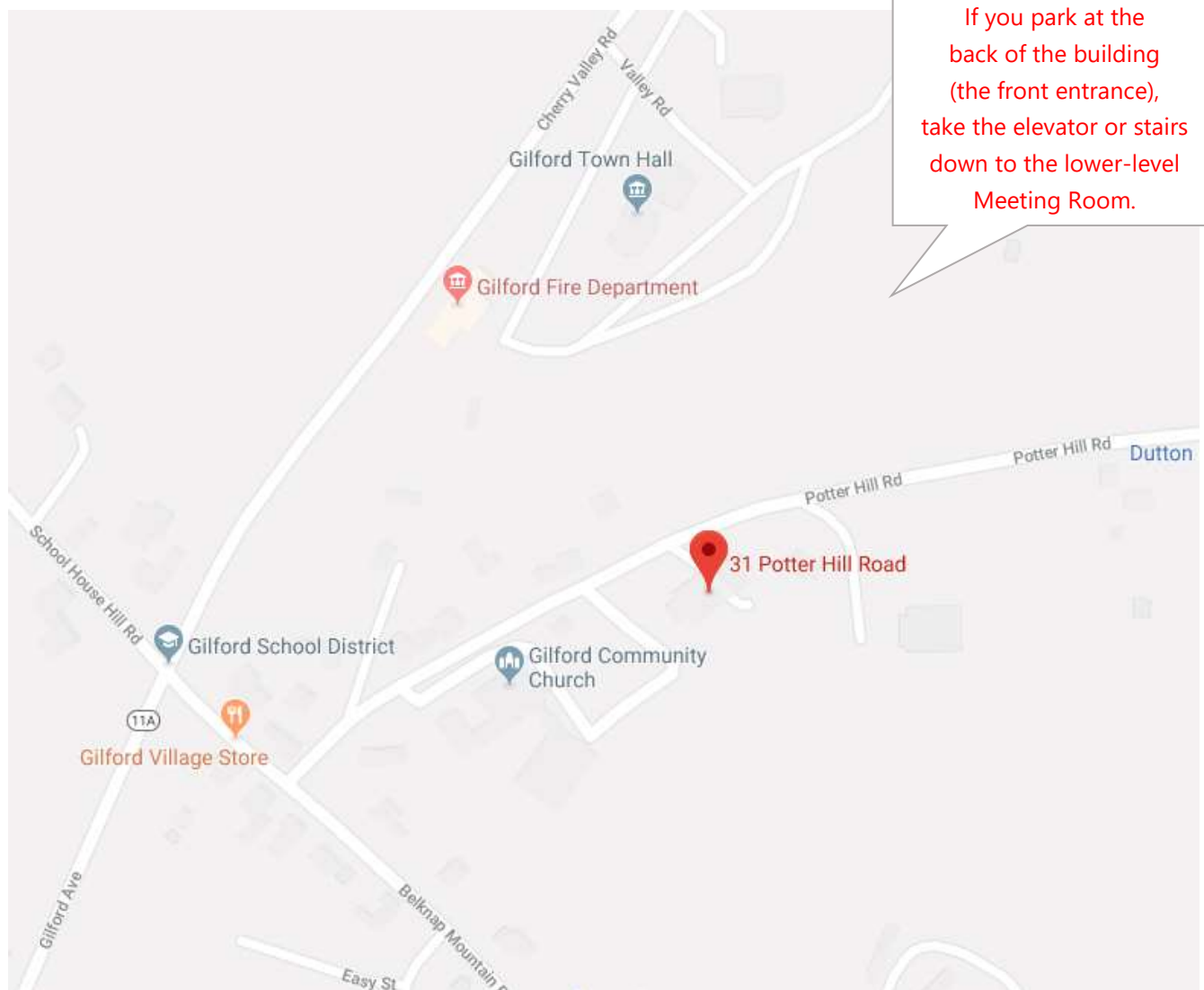

1. Call to Order

Chairman Crowley called the regular meeting of the Lakes Region Planning Commission to order at 7:14 pm at Lakes Region Community College in Laconia, following a legislative reception jointly held with Lakes Region Community College. The Chair asked for a motion to declare that a quorum existed; D. Katz so moved and K. Ober seconded; motion passed unanimously.

The Chair introduced Joanne Haight, new commissioner representing Sandwich.

2. Approval of Minutes

The Chair asked for a motion to approve the minutes of October 22, 2018 as presented; K. Ober so moved and S. Bartlett seconded; motion passed unanimously.

3. Commissioner Roundtable

State Representative Charlie St. Clair asked to speak and talked about the state of transportation in New Hampshire, especially lack of services and options and asked that Commissioners please contact him at 603-387-5944 with issues and concerns. J. Hayes noted that we are in the process of soliciting transportation projects from members for inclusion in the state plan. Several Commissioners were unable to hear Rep. St. Clair due to the meeting being held in the same room where the legislative reception was held.

The Chair asked for Commissioners' thoughts and comments and J. Hayes asked for ideas for future meetings, topics that Commissioners would like to hear about.

D. Anson suggested LRPC should consider regional recycling as a means to take the heat off municipalities who are struggling with rising costs.

D. Katz noted that we want to keep recycling behavior in place and stressed the need for positive consequences to get the desired behavior.

C. Caron and W. Crowley noted communities facing the problem of no longer being able to recycle glass.

J. Hayes indicated that there has been discussion regarding the issue and noted that Tuftonboro is looking into a grant from NBRC (Northern Border Regional Commission) for a shed/storage option to house materials until they reach critical mass for a regional purchasing effort.

S. Bartlett asked for comment on TAC projects and the amount of man hours assembling data for reports. J. Hayes stated there is a transportation funding crisis—a legislative issue—but noted there is some funding available, for which the TAC prioritizes projects submitted. He noted Moultonborough may have had 3 or 4 projects included in the last Ten Year Plan; S. Bartlett thought several were dropped off the list. J. Hayes noted he thought Moultonborough has been smart in chopping up projects into smaller bits and that projects are carried through better than ever compared to the past, a greatly improved situation.

J. Hayes asked for feedback regarding the preceding legislative reception. Commissioner feedback and ideas included:

- Have Commissioners submit questions in advance for legislators
- Location great
- Have all legislators introduce themselves; this was done last year
- Have legislators state their legislative priorities
- Get legislators together on a regular basis
- Tonight was a sort of caucus; maybe send letter thanking them and inviting to a next one
- Maybe have Selectboards invite legislators.
